#### SPECTATOR LIMITS ADJUSTED

Pursuant to KSHSAA Handbook **Bylaw VIII, Section 3**, the KSHSAA Board of Directors was asked to receive and consider the following recommendation from the KSHSAA Appeal Board at their December 4, 2020 hearing:

Because masks are already required for attendance at KSHSAA events, and because the science tells us that proper mask wearing and social-distancing effectively mitigate the risk of transmitting COVID-19, and because we believe that for several reasons, parents should attend their children's activities, we propose the KSHSAA Board of Directors be reconvened for the purposes of reconsidering the decisions to prohibit spectators at high school and junior high/middle school events through January 28, 2021 with a recommendation to allow for attendance of one or two parents/guardians per athlete.

A motion was made by M. Marlin, seconded by M. Graber to implement the following rule change for member schools during the 2020-21 school year only:

*Effective Thursday, December 10 through January 28, 2021, interscholastic activities will allow for attendance of one or two parents/guardians per athlete.* 

Following discussion, an amendment was made by J. Hines, seconded by K. Whittaker, to strike the language "one or two parents/guardians per athlete" and revise to say "up to two parents/guardians per participant(s) family as allowed by local board of education or health department". The amendment was approved by a vote of 51 in favor, 27 opposed.

An amendment was proposed by T. Bumgarner, seconded by J. McNiece, to strike the date "Thursday, December 10" and revise to "January 12". The amendment was denied by a vote of 28 in favor, 50 opposed.

An amendment was proposed by M. Garber, seconded by S. Spoonts, to strike the language "parents/guardians" and the word "family" and revise to say "family members". The amendment was denied by a vote of 10 in favor, 68 opposed.

An amendment was proposed by J. Briggs, seconded by M. Straub, to strike the date "Thursday, December 10" and revise to "December 14". Following a failed friendly amendment to revise the date again to "December 8" the amendment was denied by a vote of 33 in favor, 45 opposed.

The new written language is as follows:

*Effective Thursday, December 10 through January 28, 2021, interscholastic activities will allow for attendance of up to two parents/guardians per participant(s) family as allowed by local board of education or health department restrictions.* 

The proposal was approved by a vote of 54 in favor, 24 opposed.
