PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES: Parents of a student athlete . . .

- 1. Shall submit a signed permission slip for each child's participation in each sport. This is to be on file before participating in the first practice.
- 2. Shall arrange for transportation to and from all practices and games.
- 3. Shall be responsible for health care costs should your player become injured during practice or a game. Emmanuel Lutheran Church, Faith Lutheran Church, Emmanuel-Faith Lutheran School, the Athletic Director, Principal, coach or any other individual associated with a practice or game will not be held liable.
- 4. Shall inform the coach and athletic director if there are any restrictions due to the health conditions of the child.
- 5. Shall display good sportsmanship at all games toward all participants, including opponents and coaches; Emmanuel-Faith coaches and game officials.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES: The student . . .

- 1. Shall have attitudes and behavior such that he/she is a good Christian representative of Emmanuel-Faith athletics. Respect is to be shown to all individuals, including, but not limited to teachers, administrators, coaches, teammates, opponents and officials.
- 2. Shall make school the top priority.
