Back to School Information and Details:

Open House is Thursday, August 10th. We are excited to see all of our families in person at Open House! It is the perfect time for you to: find your child's classroom, meet your child's teacher, drop off your child's supplies, deposit lunch money, and join PTO. <u>You will receive a welcome email from your child's 2023-2024 homeroom teacher on the morning of August 10th containing a reminder regarding Open House times, information about their room number, and a Google form link for you to complete regarding specific information about your little one. We will have staff available to assist you and guide you in the right direction on Thursday, August 10th. We ask that you help keep our sod beautiful by keeping vehicles on the pavement and parking in the designated parking spots. Please attend the session by the **First Initial of your child's LAST NAME**. We have designated times for grade levels due to limited parking and the sheer size of our student body. You will also receive a postcard reminder in the mail within the week.</u>

On July 11th, our Director of Transportation, Jason Salmons, emailed information regarding bus transportation. Our Transportation Department recently converted to a new routing software called EZ Routing. As a result of that rollover, students who were assigned to a school bus last year are now assigned to a bus for the 2023-2024 academic year. Please **download the parent app BusQuest** to see your child's bus stop information. The new app also allows you to sign up or remove your child from bus service at any time. **To request new bus service or to see your bus route for this fall, download the BusQuest app and submit a request.** Bus times may fluctuate between now and the start of school on August 16th, so be sure to check your child's route information prior to the start of school. One important note for your family; once you sign up for transportation service with BusQuest, you'll still use the **BusCompass app** to see real-time updates and to know when the bus is **within three bus stops** of your child's stop. The first day of school is August 16th. Watch our school's Facebook page for a 10-day countdown with additional information and fun facts about ESE prior to the first day of school.

Students may enter the building at 7:00 a.m. and make their way to their designated gathering place outside the classroom. The first bell will ring at 7:22 a.m., and the tardy bell rings at 7:30 a.m. If you arrive after 7:30 a.m., parents must park and check students into the office. Students may enter classrooms at 7:22 a.m. Dismissal from classrooms for walkers, car riders, and bus riders will begin at 2:30 p.m.

For the first two weeks of school, all ESE staff members will be available to help students find their classrooms and get settled. Parents may walk their students to class only on the first day of school. Beginning on **August 17th**, students will need to walk to class on their own.

If your child is a car rider, for the safety of every child, we ask you to remain in your vehicle when picking your child up from school. All car riders will be issued a 2023-2024 unique number for the ESE car line. ALL car riders must have the temporary 2023-2024 ESE Car Rider Pass with this unique



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number displayed on their front dash. Two copies will be provided to families at Open House. If you do not have your 2023-2024 ESE Car Rider Pass, you will be asked to show a photo ID before we will release your child from school. Plastic car rider tags will be issued by September 1st. Since our school buses and other childcare transportation buses (Club Infiniti, Mobius, Primrose, etc.) have additional students to pick up from surrounding schools, we will hold all cars until the buses have left the ESE premises. We ask parents not to park in the designated handicap spots. These spots are reserved for only those who are authorized to park there. In the morning or the afternoon, if you need to pull around to the parking lot from our car line, we ask that you park in one of the nine open spots in the front row on the other side of the handicapped spots or in any of the other available spots throughout our parking lot. Car riders, please be patient with us. It will take a couple of weeks to establish our dismissal routine. Please be advised that our car line can take over an hour for the first few weeks. Here is a short video outlining our car line procedures: **<u>ESE Car Line</u>**. If you have never had the opportunity to participate in our car line, you are highly encouraged to view the video linked above. One final, but very important reminder. It is against the law to use your cell phone in a school zone. Our school zone spans from the Scissortail neighborhood down W. Pleasant Grove Road/Haxton Road past Gaston Road. This includes our car-rider line. Thank you for being courteous in the car line and protecting all of our owlets!

In addition, all K-4 building principals and district officials request your cooperation during the morning drop-off times between 7:00 –7:30 a.m. Your child's safety is our top priority! Should parents have a need to be in the building between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., please check in through the office and be prepared to show photo identification. Teachers and staff are happy to meet with parents by appointment. Again, we cannot reiterate enough how important your child's safety is to us, and so for that reason, we appreciate your support.

To ensure the safety of all children, we will send your child home the same way every day unless you notify our front office staff before 2:00 p.m. Additionally, a transportation and procedures letter will be provided at Open House. This letter contains detailed information about campus security, morning/afternoon car riders, bus riders, Discovery, walkers, tardies, and our district lightning procedure. If you have questions regarding your child's after-school dismissal status, please contact the school office at 479-360-7400. The office is open daily from 7:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. if you need help or have any questions.

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Additional Information

Enrollment Verification: Beginning August 1st through August 25th, your child's online records will be available for you to verify through Etrieve. To complete the required profile verification and back-to-school forms, simply log on to <u>Forms-Online Forms (Etrieve)</u> or visit our Student Services page at <u>https://www.bentonvillek12.org/page/student-services</u>.

Bentonville Schools no longer requires proof of residency on an annual basis. However, if you've had an address change, you will need to provide proof of residency to update our records through Etrieve <u>Forms-Online Forms</u>. It takes only a moment to review and confirm your child's records, but it's critical you do so by **August 25th**. The Residency Verification form is **mobile-friendly**.
