All procedures and expectations are subject to change as new restrictions are added or removed by the Labette County Health Department or the USD 503 Board of Education.

\*Grades:

- PHS: Students are considered ineligible to apply if the student failed 2 or more classes during the previous semester.
- PMS: Students that are considered ineligible to apply if they failed any courses during the previous semester.

\*Attendance: Student is ineligible to apply if the student is chronically absent or truant from school.

- Chronic is defined as 10% or greater absentee rate. This includes excused and unexcused absences.
- Truant is defined as 3 unexcused absences in a row, 5 unexcused in a semester or 7 unexcused absences in a school year.
