USD 503 Learning Plan 2nd Semester

Jan. 19, 2021-May 28, 2021

Elementary Schools

All students return to face to face learning.

Exceptions for:

- Students on quarantine
- Student or student household members with a documented medical condition that puts them in a highrisk category for complications related to COVID-19

Students on quarantine (grades Pre-k-5) will participate in remote learning (packet or device- building decision)

Secondary Schools

Face to Face Learning or Limited Remote Learning (with approved application)

Parents may apply for their child to remote learn and decisions will be made based on the following criteria: (Those who do not qualify based on a medical condition must meet both the attendance and grade criteria in order to be approved.)

- 1. Student or student household members with a documented medical condition that puts them in a high-risk category for complications related to COVID-19
- 2. Student attendance
 - Student can not be chronically absent or truant from school
- 3. Student academics
 - MS- students must have passed all courses first semester
 - HS- students must not have failed two or more classes first semester
- Students approved as remote learners for second semester must remain students in good standing with attendance and grades in order to continue to participate in remote learning.
- Remote applications will be made available to families January 13, 2021 and must be returned in by Jan. 18, 2021
- Remote applications would be reviewed by admin/staff and a determination made by January 19, 2021

Some courses, due to their nature, may be unavailable based on course requirements. Testing centers and science labs will be made available at specific times.

Remote learning would continue for students on quarantine.

Students would be responsible for zooming into their classes each hour and their coursework as assigned.
