

- Renewing awarded applicants in all states will NOT be required to upload income documentation. Renewing awarded applicants simply need to complete the application portion and submit for their awarded students to remain on scholarship! ACE hopes that this simplifies the process for our returning awarded families.
- If you submitted your FACTS Financial Aid application prior to February 6, 2023, you must now add ACE Scholarships to your FACTS application in order to be considered for an ACE award. This is done by checking the box under Organizations, ACE and then completing the ACE application additional requirements.

The Department of Health and Human Services published their 2023 Federal Poverty Level guidelines earlier this month, and the ACE Board of Directors approved raising the maximum qualifying income to 350% of Federal Poverty Guidelines. As a result, the maximum qualifying income guideline chart for ACE scholarships for the 2023- 2024 school year is as follows:

Household Size	2023 Federal Poverty Guideline (EPG)	ACE Maximum Qualifying Income
2	\$19,720	\$69,020
3	\$24,860	\$87,010
4	\$30,000	\$105,000
5	\$35,140	\$122,990
6	\$40,280	\$140,980
7	\$45,420	\$158,970
8	\$50,560	\$176,960

For each additional person, add: \$5,140 \$17,990
