SUPERINTENDENT UPDATE

Dear Parents and Community Members,

The City of Hermantown is continuing to move forward with plans to build a new arena on school property with construction starting in the fall of 2024. The school is granting an easement for the building site for 37.5 years, which is the length of time required for the bonding the city received.

Once the arena construction is finished, the city is granting ownership and management rights for the arena to the school. We still plan to have HAHA manage the arena. After 37.5 years, the school will take full ownership of the arena. The construction will be on the West side of the current arena and the district office will stay where it is currently located.

MENZEL SELECTED TO MN HS FOOTBALL ALL-STAR GAME || The Minnesota Vikings and the Minnesota Football Coaches Association announced that Peyton Menzel was selected to compete in the 50th annual Minnesota High School Football All Star Game presented by Andersen Windows and Doors on Saturday, December 2 at U.S. Bank Stadium.

MFCA ALL-STATE ACADEMIC AWARDS || The Minnesota Football Coaches Association announced that Hermantown senior Connor Fure was a Class 4A Individual Academic All-State selection and that the Hawks earned Team Academic All-State Silver honors with a 3.18 team GPA. **STATE PARTICIPANTS** || Junior Norah Gunderson and senior Ava Niksich qualified individually for the MSHSL Girls Swimming and Diving State Tournament. Gunderson was named the Section Swimmer of the Year after placing first in the 200 IM with a team-record time of 2:17.80 and second in the 100 fly with a team-record time of 1:02.88. Niksich earned her trip to state after placing first in both the 200 free and 500 free with times of 2:02.97 and 5:34.25, respectively. Jon Nelson was named the Section Head Coach of the Year and the team was awarded the Section GPA Award, silver standard.
