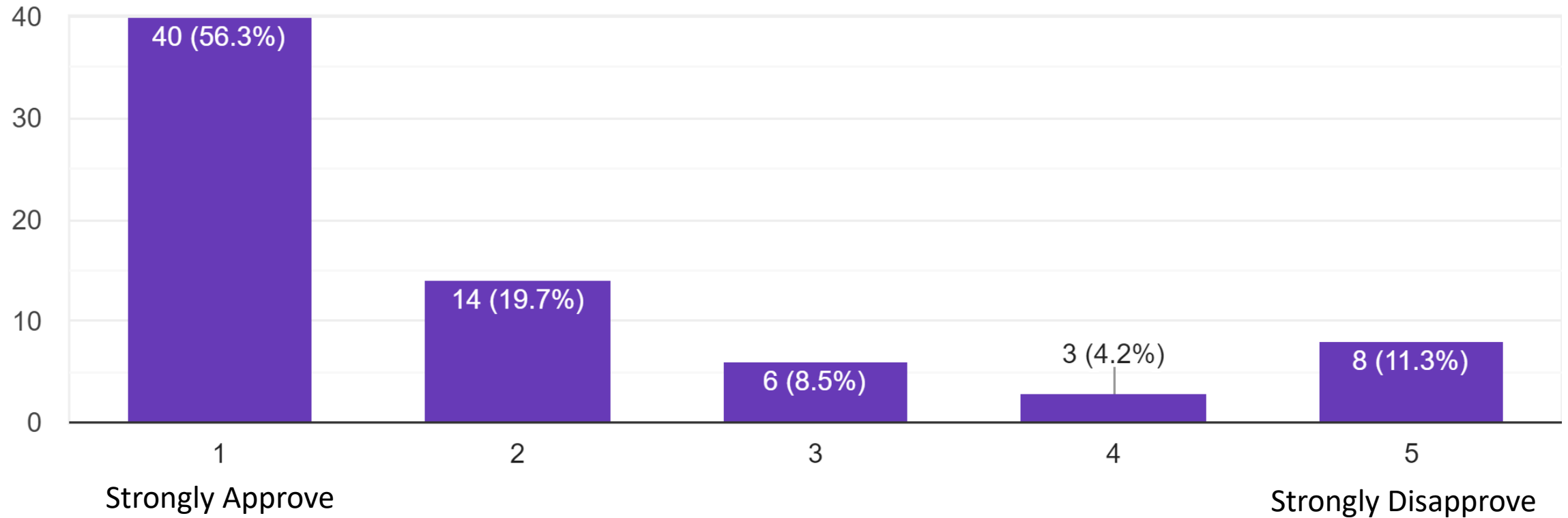


2021-22 School Year Plan

71 responses



- 54 respondents (76%) strongly approve (1) or approve (2)
- 11 respondents (15.5%) strongly disapprove (5) or disapprove (4)

- **10** comments raised concerns about wearing masks indoors and/or said masks should be optional
- **8** comments said they were happy with the plan/ no changes
- **6** comments raised concerns about students eating together in the cafeteria

## Trends:

*What concerns do you have about the DRAFT Blue Plan?*

- **5** comments raised concerns about wearing masks indoors and/or said masks should be optional
- **5** comments said they had no immediate concerns
- **3** comments raised concerns about students eating together in the cafeteria
- **3** comments had concerns about pooled testing or wanted more information
- **2** comments said the plan was too long or detailed

## Trends:

*Do you have questions about any part of the plan?*

- **6** questions about why students are being made to wear masks inside and why this is not optional
- **3** questions about students eating together in the cafeteria
- There were also questions asking why the school is **promoting vaccination**, parent/community **access to the building**, and how the school will **change/review the plan**. These topics came up in other sections of the survey as well

# Trends: *Comments*

- 8 comments expressed support for the plan
- 6 comments stated that masks should not be required
- 3 comments recommended pooled testing

# Overall Survey Trends:

- **Support for plan** and gratitude for work developing it
- Concerns and **opposition to mask requirement**
- Concerns about **students eating together in the cafeteria**
- Concerns about **parent/community access to building**
- Concerns that school is promoting or will require **student vaccination**
- **Pooled testing** – questions, opposition, and support
- Need for **consistent mask breaks**
- Questions about how the school will **review and change the plan** during the school year
