PHS/ PMS Remote Application Rubric 2nd Semester - Spring 2021

Families that can demonstrate a documented medical condition that would put them at high risk for complications related to Covid-19 would automatically qualify for remote learning. Those who do not qualify based on medical condition must meet both the attendance and grade criteria in order to be approved for remote learning.

Criteria	Criteria Met
Medical Condition: Student or household member has a medical condition that is documented that puts them in a high risk category for complications related to Covid-19	
*Must provide medical documentation	
Attendance: Student is not chronically absent or truant from school.	
Chronic is defined as 10% or greater absentee rate. This includes excused and unexcused absences.	
Truant is defined as three unexcused absences in a row, five unexcused absences in a semester or seven unexcused absences in a school year.	
Grades: PHS: Students that are considered ineligible, failing two or more classes, will not be allowed to enroll, or continue, with remote learning. PMS: Students that are considered ineligible for extra curricular activities (must not be failing any courses) will not be allowed to enroll or continue with remote learning.
