

Dear St. George Families,

As a school community, we developed the Return to School Handbook to help protect the health, safety, and wellbeing of our students, staff, and community. We cannot eliminate all risks, but to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19, and other illnesses, we are asking every family to pledge to conduct a brief health screening of their child before sending them to school. School staff are following a similar protocol. For this approach to work we need to screen our children every day and keep children home if they are sick
